In view of the averments made in the application, same is allowed and affidavit of Yogesh Gupta, Superintending Engineer/Admn.-I, Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited, Panchkula, on behalf of respondent No.2 along with office order dated 17.04.2026 (Annexure R-2/10) is taken on record. Learned counsel appearing for different power utilities i.e. Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited, Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited and Haryana Vidyut Prasaran Nigam Limited, submit that the grievance raised by the petitioners in these writ petitions has substantially been redressed, as impugned clause has been withdrawn, in which the provision for transfer of Assistant Engineer, Assistant Executive Engineer, Junior Engineer and Junior Engineer-I was incorporated.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that they are satisfied with the stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents-different power utilities and as such, these three petitions may be disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.
