1. Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the action of respondents for not adhering to the provisions of Reservation Policy dated 15.07.2014 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Government of Haryana and not considering the petitioners for promotion to the post of *Kanungo* despite fulfilling the eligibility for promotion and having vacant seats of *Kanungo* in District Rohtak.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage limits his prayer and submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondents to consider and take a final decision on legal representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) made by the petitioners in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Ruchi Sekhri, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that she has no objection in case the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners at this stage, is accepted.



5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without going into the merits of the present petition, the same is **disposed of** with a direction to the respondents/Competent Authority, concerned, to forthwith consider and decide the aforesaid legal representation dated 05.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners by passing a speaking and reasoned order, in accordance with law, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
