1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioners in view of policy decision dated 29.07.2011, notification dated 17.01.2012 without insisting on the condition of continuous service of 10 years as on 10.04.2026 and in terms of the law laid down in **Jaggo vs. Union of India and others** 2024 SCC Online SC 3836. Regarding the claim raised in the present petition, a representation dated 11.05.2026, Annexure P-6, has been submitted, which has yet not evoked any response. Learned counsel, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same keeping in view the aforesaid judgment and policy/notification, in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.



3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 11.05.2026, Annexure P-6, taking note of the aforesaid judgment and policy/notification, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
