1. Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to permit the petitioner to join service and to issue appointment/joining letter to her for the post of Sub-Inspector in Punjab Police for which she has been duly selected in accordance with the judgment dated 04.09.2025 (Annexure P-10), passed in CWP-20661 of 2023 – Sonam Kamboj v. State of Punjab and others and the applicable recruitment rules and for directing the respondents to grant the petitioner all consequential benefits arising from such appointment, including seniority and all other service benefits admissible under law from the date of appointment.

2. After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail other legal remedies in accordance with law, including the remedy



of contempt for implementation of judgment dated 04.09.2025
(Annexure P-10) passed in CWP-20661 of 2023.
