SHALINI SINGH NAGPAL, J. (oral)

The writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India
seeks following directions to official respondents:-

- (i) To protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands
of private respondents No. 4 and 5;
- (ii) To decide representation dated 02.03.2026 (Annexure
P-1) submitted by the petitioner in time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was
owner of agricultural land measuring 1 acre situated in Jandiala-1, District
Amritsar. Petitioner and respondents No. 4 and 5 were engaged in transport
business as partners, which was operated from the said property of
petitioner. The partnership ceased to exist, yet taking undue advantage,
private respondents unlawfully retained possession of the land and refused to
vacate the same.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that appropriate direction be issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Amritsar, Punjab to consider and decide representation dated 02.03.2026(Annexure P-1) moved by petitioner and take necessary action thereupon in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

5. Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and on instructions submits that petitioner's representation was pending consideration and the needful shall be done in due course.

6. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Amritsar, Punjab to decide the representation dated 02.03.2026 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from today, by passing a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.

7. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in he representation, the petitioner shall be duly informed as per mandate of law.

8. Petition stands disposed of.

All the miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
