1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.29 dated 02.03.2025, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Ropar, District Ropar.

2. As per the allegations in the FIR, while the police team was checking suspects, the petitioner was noticed riding a motorcycle bearing registration No. PB-12 AJ-2987. Upon conducting his search, three transparent envelopes containing narcotic injections were found, which were kept in a black plastic envelope hanging on the left side of the handle of the motorcycle. A total of 12 Buprenorphine injections IP (Leegesic), each of 2 ml, were recovered.

3. Since the petitioner is involved in three other cases under the NDPS Act, learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as withdrawn at this stage.
