1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 3 to 5 so that they may not become a victim of continuous oppression and violence inflicted upon them by the official respondents with a further prayer that respondents No. 3 to 5 not to make harassment to the petitioner by calling them at the police station time and again.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondents No. 3 to 5, are repeatedly summoning the petitioners to the police station time and again without assigning any reason and without adopting the proper procedure of law. He further submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, Punjab in this regard; however, no action has been taken thereon. It is contended that the petitioners have a genuine apprehension of being falsely implicated and



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subjected to unnecessary harassment at the hands of the official respondents. Accordingly, it is prayed that appropriate protection be granted to the petitioners in accordance with law and that, in the event their presence is required for any enquiry or investigation, prior notice be served upon them.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. Mr. P.S.Pandher, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that investigation shall be carried out as per law.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, as well as the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents that, in case the presence of the petitioners are required for the purpose of any enquiry or investigation in the present case, they shall be served with a written notice at least three days in advance before requiring their appearance in accordance with law.

7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
