JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release payment with respect to work carried out by it for the respondents along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. Ms. Tanvi Aggarwal, Advocate has appeared and filed Power of Attorney on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.



3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that admitted liability would be discharged within four months from today subject to verification.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents may be subjected to interest @ 12% per annum from the date of passing bills.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands **disposed of** with a direction to respondents to release payment to the petitioner within four months from today. If payment is not released within aforesaid period, the respondents would be liable to pay interest @ 9% per annum from the expiry of said period. The petitioner is at liberty to approach appropriate authority qua disputed amount, if any.

6. Pending Misc. application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
