1. The appellant-claimants have filed the present appeal seeking enhancement of the compensation amount of ₹5,90,000/- awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, SAS Nagar (Mohali) (for short- 'the learned Tribunal') vide impugned Award dated 02.07.2016, passed in claim petition bearing No. MACP/152/2014 dated 22.05.2014/ 26.04.2016 filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 13.02.2026, when this case was listed for hearing, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants prays that present appeal may be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties.

4. Learned counsel for the parties are also *ad idem* that the matter stands settled between the parties by way of Settlement/Agreement dated 18.04.2026. As such, nothing survives in the present appeal and the same may be disposed of, accordingly.
