By way of present revision petition, challenge has been laid to the orders dated 12.10.2021 & 16.09.2022 passed by the Courts below, whereby the petitioners-defendants, in a suit for possession by way of partition as well as for permanent injunction, preferred at the instance of respondent Nos. 1 to 5-plaintiffs, were restrained from changing the nature of the suit property during its pendency.

[2] As informed by the learned respective counsel(s), the suit stands listed today before the learned trial Court for rebuttal, if any, and arguments. In such circumstances, in the humble opinion of this Court, no ground to interference with the impugned orders is made out, whereby the petitioners-defendants were restrained from changing the nature of the suit property, especially when the said interim order has remained in operation
