This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 & 2 to handover the investigation of the present case bearing FIR No.134 dated 22.10.2021 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 [now Sections 318(4) and 61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023] and Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1908 at Police Station Nayagaon, District SAS Nagar Mohali to respondent No.3-Bureau of Investigation, Punjab for proper, fair and impartial investigation and to arrest the accused persons as well as to file the challan/final report against the accused persons.

2. After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel



appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
