**H.S. GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 17.02.2025 U/s 303(2), 317(2) and 3(5) of BNS registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 12.08.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dera Bassi and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dera Bassi has submitted copy of report dated 08.10.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.



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4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 18 dated 17.02.2025 U/s 303(2), 317(2) and 3(5) of BNS registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) subject to payment of Rs. 20,000/- as costs in the High Court Employees Welfare Fund, A/c No. 37167209613, State Bank of India, High Court Branch, Chandigarh.
