SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 20.04.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-2107-2022 and connected writ petitions.

2. Learned counsel for respondent contends that in compliance of order dated 20.04.2023, affidavit of Dr. Avnish Kumar, Director, Medical Education & Research, Punjab, dated 02.09.2025 along with Annexures R-1 and R-2 has already been filed on behalf of respondent No.2.

3. A perusal of affidavit dated 02.09.2025 shows that order dated 20.04.2023 passed in CWP-2107-2022 has been complied with.

4. In view of the same, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
