By way of present writ petition, prayer has been made for setting aside the order dated 13.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Court of learned District & Session Judge, Jalandhar, whereby reference petition preferred under Section 3H(4) of the National Highway Act, 1956, seeking apportionment of compensation, was disposed of.
