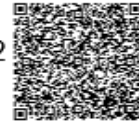

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail for the petitioner in FIR No. 59 dated 28.05.2025 under Sections 21(c), 61 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Gurdaspur, Police District Batala, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court, vide order dated 06.03.2026, had directed the petitioner to appear before the SHO/ Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the SHO/ Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.).

3. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has involved himself in another case, i.e., FIR No. 21 dated 22.02.2026.



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4. I have heard the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, particularly the involvement of the petitioner in another case bearing FIR No. 21 dated 22.02.2026, as pointed out by learned State counsel, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
