VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

The prayer in the present petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short, 'the BNSS') is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.86, dated 12.07.2026 registered at Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 21(b), 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short the "NDPS Act") (and Section 29 of NDPS Act added subsequently).

2. On 24.08.2026, the following order was passed by this Bench:-

"Prayer in the present petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short the "BNSS") is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.86, dated 12.07.2026 registered under Sections 21(b), 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short the "NDPS Act") (and Section 29 of NDPS Act added subsequently) at Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran.

On 12.07.2026, one Ranjit Singh was apprehended and 7 grams of heroin along with Rs.200 is alleged to have been recovered from him. During his interrogation, he named the



present petitioner in his disclosure statement as a result of which, the petitioner was arraigned as an accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. He submits that there is no other evidence to connect the petitioner with the offence except the disclosure statement. He submits that no recovery has been made from the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has clean antecedents and is willing to join investigation and abide by any condition imposed by the Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ravinder Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 09.09.2026.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation. In the event of arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to compliance of the provisions of Section 482(2) BNSS.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with the aforesaid order, the petitioner has duly joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran, who is present in Court, submits that in compliance with the order dated 24.08.2026, the petitioner has duly joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 24.08.2026 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to compliance of the provisions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
