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**Sumeet Goel, J. (Oral):**

1. The substantive prayer made in the instant petition reads thus:

*“In view of the submissions made, it is most respectfully prayed that the record of the case may kindly be called for and after perusal of the same, to:*

*1) Issue directions to the Ld. Additional District Judge-Cum Special Judge, Amritsar to expedite the trial in NDPS Case no. 683/2025 dated 05.08.2025 in crime no. 04/2025 dated 07.02.2025, Annexure P-1, to take up the case on day to day basis in the interest of justice.”*

Faced with the situation that the petitioner has not filed any application under Section 346 of BNSS (erstwhile Section 309 of Cr.P.C), learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the petition in hand, so as to enable the petitioner to file such like application before the concerned trial Court in the first instance.
