NEERJA K. KALSON J.(Oral)

1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of the private respondents No.5 and 6. A further prayer has also been made for issuance of an appropriate order or direction to consider and decide the representations/applications dated 24.08.2026 and 25.08.2026 (Annexures P-6 and P-7).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted representations on 24.08.2026 and 25.08.2026 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) to respondents No.3 and 4, raising the grievances raised in the present petition, but no action has been taken thereon so far.



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He further submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation in a time-bound manner and to take action in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Yatin Bunker, Astt. A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and submits that the needful shall be done in accordance with law. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga, is directed to look into the representation dated 25.08.2026 (Annexure P-7) and decide the same, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
