1. The present petition has been filed seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 08.08.2026, under Sections 303(2), 345(3), 3(5) of BNS [corresponding Sections 379, 482, 34 of IPC], registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Jalandhar.

2. After vehemently arguing on the merits of the case and finding that the Court is not inclined to grant any concession to the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner sought permission to withdraw the instant petition and has volunteered that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within five days from today. He further prayed that a direction be issued to the learned trial Court



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that, in case the petitioner applies for regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of five days.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the said bail application should be decided on its own merits and not guided by the present order.

4. Considering the above request and in light of the volunteered statement of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready to surrender, he may do so within a period of five days and in case, the petitioner applies for regular bail thereafter, the same be decided expeditiously, preferably within five working days.

5. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case.

6. However, it is made clear that this order shall not be construed as any direction of granting or not granting a bail and the said application shall be considered on its own merits, in accordance with law and without being influenced by this order.
