VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to ensure the protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 who are openly giving threats to the petitioner to involve her and her daughter in a false case and extending threat to her life and liberty as respondent No.5 who is real brother of the petitioner in connivance with respondent No.4 is demanded money illegally. A direction has been further sought to the official respondents to take action and decide the representation dated 03.06.2026/02.09.2026 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner submitted a representation dated 03.06.2026/02.09.2026 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, and he would be satisfied if appropriate direction be issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 03.06.2026/02.09.2026 (Annexure P-



1) moved by petitioner and take necessary action thereupon in a time **2026:PHHC:126878** manner in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. Mr. J.S. Rattu, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the representation submitted by the petitioner has already been decided and consigned. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner is not satisfied with the action taken on the said representation and would be satisfied if the present petition itself be treated as a representation and respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the grievance raised by the petitioner, in accordance with law.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to treat the present petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and consider the grievance raised therein, in accordance with law, expeditiously.

6. It is clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the grievance raised by the petitioner and respondent No.2 shall take a decision strictly in accordance with law.

7. Petition stands disposed of.

8. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
