1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of the private respondents No.5 to 7. A further prayer has also been made for issuance of an appropriate order or direction to consider and decide the representation dated 24.07.2026 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted representation on 24.07.2026 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.4, raising the grievances raised in the present petition, but no action has been taken thereon so far. He further submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation in a time-bound manner and to take action in accordance with law.
