1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 (Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure) for quashing of impugned order dated 29.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed by Ld. JMIC, Gurdaspur vide which petitioner's bail order has been cancelled and surety bonds have been forfeited to the State and non-bailable warrants were issued with a further prayer for quashing of impugned order dated 31.01.2026 (Annexure P-4) passed by Ld. JMIC, Gurdaspur vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed person in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 23.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Section 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC (corresponding Sections 118(2), 118(1), 115(2), 3(5) BNS), PS Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not appear before the learned trial Court due to communication gap with his counsel to face trial. As such, petitioner's bail order has been cancelled and bail/surety bonds have been forfeited to the State and non-bailable warrants were issued against him vide order dated 29.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) and he was declared proclaimed person vide order dated

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31.01.2026 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the Court and prays that the impugned order be set aside.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. I have heard the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the case file.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, this Court does not find any legitimate ground to interfere in the impugned orders dated 29.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) and order dated 31.01.2026 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Gurdaspur. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within next 07 working days from today at 10:00 A.M. and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be considered and decided by the Court concerned on the same very day, keeping in view the compromise having been effected between the parties.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
