Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No.0300 dated 24.12.2025, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri. This is the first petition for anticipatory bail.

It is alleged that petitioners, in connivance with Revenue officials and others prepared forged Wills of Purna, Chano and Subh Ram and got mutation sanctioned in respect of ancestral land in their favour in village Gopi.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners and complainant were related. Dispute between the parties, regarding ancestral properties were subject matter of civil suits. The matter had now been compromised between the complainant and the petitioners. Pursuant to the compromise, the civil suits were withdrawn. He refers to compromise deed Annexure P-4, dated 02.05.2026, executed after the registration of the FIR



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between Krishan, Ramesh Kumar, on one hand and petitioners and others accused, on the other hand.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vikas Bhardwaj, AAG Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioners was not required as petitioners had already joined investigation. Mr. Sanjeev Vijaramya, Advocate for respondent No.2, does not dispute the factum of compromise.

In the given facts and circumstances of the case, the petition for anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioners shall surrender before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join investigation within one week or as and when required. In the event of their arrest, the Investigating/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioners on anticipatory bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to his/her satisfaction. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
