1. The present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner/plaintiff for setting aside the order dated 20.08.2026 (Annexure P-6) passed by the trial Court, whereby the ad interim injunction granted in favour of the petitioner/plaintiff till 17.09.2026 vide order dated 18.08.2026 (Annexure P-4) was withdrawn on an application seeking early hearing of the case (Annexure P-5) filed by respondents No.2 and 3/defendants No.2 and 3.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner/plaintiff submits that vide order dated 18.08.2026 (Annexure P-4), ad interim injunction was granted in favour of the petitioner/plaintiff till 17.09.2026. However, on an application filed by respondents No.2 and 3/defendants No.2 and 3 seeking early hearing of the main case, the said injunction was withdrawn vide order dated 20.08.2026 (Annexure P-6).



3. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner/plaintiff will be satisfied if a direction is given to the trial Court to decide the application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (Annexure P-2), filed by the petitioner/plaintiff, on the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court, i.e. 17.09.2026.

4. Taking into consideration the nature of the prayer made in this revision petition, it is not necessary to issue notice to the respondents.

5. In light of the limited prayer made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner/plaintiff, the present revision petition is disposed of with a request to the trial Court to make every endeavour to decide the abovesaid application (Annexure P-2) on the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court, i.e. 17.09.2026, in accordance with law.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
