NIDHI GUPTA J. (Oral)

Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 11.7.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP-19131-2025 titled as “Subhash Dahiya vs. State of Haryana and others”, whereby the petition was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Estate Officer, Haryana Urban Development Authority, Rohtak “...to look into the pending representation dated 24.6.2025 (Annexure P-9) and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order....”.

Learned counsel for the respondents has referred to the Compliance Report dated 24.3.2026 filed by way of affidavit of Shri



Ashish Kumar, HCS, Estate Officer, HSVP, Rohtak and submits that necessary compliance has been made while passing a Speaking Order dated 20.3.2026 (Annexure R-1); thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid Compliance Report alongwith Speaking order dated 20.3.2026 (Annexure R-1) filed by the learned counsel for the respondents in the Registry are taken on record. Copy thereof are supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the Writ Court order dated 11.7.2025 (Annexure P-2) has been complied with while passing a Speaking Order dated 20.3.2026 (Annexure R-1) by the respondent-authority, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same may be disposed of.

In view of the above noted facts and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is **disposed of**.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
