1. Defendant No. 3/plaintiff is in second appeal against the judgment of reversal dated 29.08.2018 whereby the appeal filed by plaintiff/respondents No. 1 and 2 was allowed by the learned Additional District Judge, Hisar; and the judgment and decree dated 20.12.2013 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Hisar dismissing the suit for declaration with consequential relief of permanent injunction filed by the plaintiff, was set aside.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 16.02.2026 when this case was listed for hearing, following order has been passed by this Court:-

Prayer in this application filed under Order XXII Rules 4 and 11 read with Section 151 CPC and Volume V, Chapter 1, Part C, Rule 5(b) and Orders of Punjab and Haryana High Court for impleading and bringing on record the LRs of respondent No. 1-Bishamber Nath(since deceased).

It is stated that appellant/respondent No. 1 died on 22.11.2019, during the pendency of the present appeal



leaving behind no other legal heirs fully detailed in para No. 2 of the application.

For the reasons stated in the application, duly supported by the affidavit, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions and the persons detailed in para No. 2 of the application are permitted to be brought on record as legal representatives of deceased/respondent No. 1 for the purpose of pursuing the present appeal.

Amended memo of parties filed along with the application is taken on record.

Registry to place the same at the proper place in the paper-book.

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*At the joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court in view of the ‘**Special Mediation Drive-Mediation for Nation-2.0**’, initiated under the aegis of the Hon’ble Supreme Court for exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties as the dispute in the present case is between the family members.*

*Learned counsel for the parties undertake that they shall duly put in appearance before Dr. Amarpreet Kaur Sandhu, Coordinator, Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court (Mobile No. 98888-81287) on **16.03.2026** at 10:00 A.M.*

*Adjourned to **22.04.2026**, for awaiting report of the Mediator.”*

3. Pursuant thereto, report dated 16.03.2026 has been received from the Mediator, as per which matter has been settled between the parties by way of Settlement/Compromise dated 16.03.2026.

4. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the entire dispute which is the subject matter of the present second appeal stands settled between the parties by way of Settlement/Compromise dated 16.03.2026 arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. It is, accordingly, prayed that the present second appeal may be disposed of in terms of aforesaid Settlement/Compromise arrived at between the parties.

5. Heard.



6. In view of the afore-noted facts and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, the present second appeal stands **disposed of**, in terms of Settlement/Compromise dated 16.03.2026.

7. Learned counsel for the parties have jointly submit that the aforesaid Settlement/Compromise dated 16.03.2026 be made part of the decree-sheet; and the decree-sheet may also be modified as per the said Settlement/Compromise.

8. Ordered accordingly.

9. It is needless to say that both the parties shall abide by the terms and conditions of the aforesaid Settlement/Compromise dated 16.03.2026

10. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
