**NIDHI GUPTA J. (Oral)**

Since all the aforesaid appeals arising out of the same Award dated 01.09.2023 passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sonipat, the same are being taken up altogether and vide this common order are being disposed of.

The present appeals have been filed by the owner of the offending vehicle.

At the very outset, it is submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that all the three appeals have been rendered infructuous as the execution petitions pending before the Executing Court stands satisfied in all the three cases as payment of the compensation awarded by the learned Tribunal have been disbursed by the appellant(s) to the respondent/claimant in all the three cases. The copies of the orders of the Executing Court dated 02.8.2025 passed in Execution Petition No.66 of 2024 titled as “Deepak vs. Gagan Deep etc.”, Execution Petition No.67 of 2024 titled as “Manisha vs. Gagan deep etc.”; and Execution Petition No.68 of 2024 titled as “Daksh Rathee vs. Gagan Deep etc.” have been handed over in the Court, which are taken on record.
