VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (corresponding to Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973), seeking directions to the official respondents No. 2 to 5 to take appropriate legal action against and/or arrest the accused, namely respondent No. 6, in FIR No. 36 dated 09.02.2025, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, and corresponding provisions under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, including Sections 316 and 318(4), as applicable, and to take appropriate action in accordance with law in respect of the offences under Sections 115(2) and 303 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents only.



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3. Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Agency to file a status report within a period of 15 days before Area Magistrate spelling out the reasons as to why the investigation has not reached its logical end in spite of the lapse of nearly 18 months.

5. Petition stands disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
