The instant petition has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No. 52 dated 17.03.2025 for offence(s) under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulations) Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 01.10.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required for investigation of the case.

3. Learned State counsel on instruction from the Investigating Officer, corroborates the said averment and submits that further custodial



interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is ***allowed*** and the interim order dated 01.10.2025 is made absolute.
