1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release its pending dues and security amount including interest.

2. Affidavit filed on behalf of respondent No.5 is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.5 submits that amount claimed by the petitioner is highly disputed and cannot be released. The petitioner has remedy to invoke arbitration proceedings as per terms and condition of the agreement.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert aforesaid factual and legal position.

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5. In the backdrop, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to avail remedy as permissible by law.
