Main case

1. Present appeal has been filed challenging the order dated 15.10.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, whereby the application filed by the appellant for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.225 dated 20.07.2025, under Section 115(2), 190, 191(3), 333 and 351(2) of BNS (Sections 3(2)(v) and 3(1)(s) of SC&ST Act, 2018, added later on), registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.
2. Vide order dated 02.02.2026, the appellant was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, the appellant has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has stated that appellant has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, order dated 15.10.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad is *set aside* and interim order dated 02.02.2026 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Appeal stands allowed.
