The petitioner seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 in case bearing Rapat No.36 dated 14.10.2023 under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar in cross-case bearing FIR No.105 dated 14.10.2023 under Sections 307, 458, 324, 323, 427, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 11.03.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 11.03.2026 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 11.03.2026 is made absolute.



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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

The petition stands disposed of.
