1. Present petitions have been filed by the petitioners, seeking grant of regular bail, in case, FIR No.11, dated 06.02.2025, under Sections 21 of NDPS Act and sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

2. As per the allegations, accused persons, namely Gurjant Singh @ Janta, Amandeep Singh @ Amna, and Dilpreet Singh, were

apprehended while travelling in a car, bearing registration No.PB-47F-0550, and 520 grams of heroin was recovered from the said vehicle.

3. From the possession of the petitioner—accused, Dilpreet Singh, one pistol along with three live cartridges was also recovered.

4. At this stage, learned State counsel submits that petitioner-Dilpreet Singh, was previously involved in two other cases under the NDPS Act, and in one of those cases, recovery of 8 kilograms of heroin had been effected from him.

5. Faced with the situation, counsel for both the petitioners seek withdrawal of the present petitions, at this stage.

6. Accordingly, present petitions stand disposed of as having been withdrawn, at this stage.
