**HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J. (Oral)**

1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings under Article 215 of the Constitution read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 (*for short, 'the Act'*), against the respondent for willful disobedience of the directions issued by this Court in CWP-PIL-80-2025 vide order dated 25.08.2025 (Annexure P-1). The operative part of the same is extracted hereunder:-

*"5. The petitioner has already made a representation dated 06.03.2025 (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.6-Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram, which is directed to be decided on its own merits within a period of 30 days after affording due and sufficient opportunity to the other side.*

*6. Thereafter, if the petitioner is aggrieved, he is free to prefer an appeal before the State Level Scrutiny Committee."*

2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Mr. Uttam Singh, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram, along with Annexure R-1, has been filed, which is taken on record. A copy thereof be



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supplied to the opposite side, during the course of the day. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the sole respondent submits that the matter was examined by the competent authority and after affording an opportunity to the concerned parties, a detailed speaking order dated 21.10.2025 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, nothing survives in the present petition and consequently, the same is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail appropriate alternate remedy. Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to assail the correctness of order dated 21.10.2025 aforesaid, as per law, if so advised.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
