1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.255 dated 29.08.2025, registered under Sections 108, 3(5), of BNS, at Police Station Farukhnagar, District Gurugram.
2. Vide order dated 02.02.2026, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 02.02.2026, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.
