1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Writ Court in CWP-10465-2025, titled as 'Ashwani Kumar vs. The Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Panchkula and others', whereby the writ petition was disposed of on the submission of learned counsel for the respondents that the Competent Authority would decide the grievance of the petitioner within a period of 03 months.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 12.01.2026, following order has been passed by this Court:-

Compliance report dated 10.01.2026, filed by way of affidavit of Sh. Pawan Kumar Verma, Superintending Engineer, HSVP Circle Panchkula, on behalf of the respondents is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner (through V.C.) submits that advance copy of the aforesaid compliance report has not been supplied to her.



Learned counsel for the respondents undertakes to supply a complete copy of compliance report to learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for time to go through the compliance report and address arguments.

At her request, adjourned to 24.04.2026.”

3. Learned counsel for the respondents points that in compliance of the order dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-1), Speaking Order dated 11.12.2025 (Annexure R-1) has been duly passed. As such, nothing survives in the present petition.

4. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, despite the case having been called twice.

5. In view of the facts noted above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition; and the same stands **disposed of**, accordingly.
