1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case bearing FIR No.151 dated 27.08.2025 registered under Sections 318(4), 316(2), 61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. Reply dated 23.04.2026 by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sangrur on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in Court today which is taken on record and a copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 10.11.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.
