Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Lakhewali; order dated 08.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Collector, Sri Muktsar Sahib; order dated 24.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Ferozepur; and order dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab.

2. A perusal of the order sheets would reveal that on the last date of hearing, i.e. 02.02.2026, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ A perusal of the order sheets reveals that the matter has been repeatedly adjourned twice either on account of absence



or at the request of learned counsel for the petitioners. Even today, when the matter was taken up for hearing in the morning, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners sought a pass over, and thereafter, on second call, again request for an adjournment has been made.

At her request and as a last indulgence, adjourned to 11.05.2026.”

3. However, today, despite second call, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

4. Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
