1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release its pending dues including security.

2. Affidavit filed on behalf of respondent No.3 is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for respondents submits that as per their record liability arising out of contract has already been discharged. If the petitioner claims any amount over and above the admitted liability, it may avail remedy as permissible by law.

4. This Court cannot adjudicate disputed question of facts. This Court can ask respondents to pay admitted liability. Accordingly, the petition
