**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J.** (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 14.08.2025 whereby execution petition filed by him against order dated 12.11.2024 was dismissed. He is further seeking direction to respondent No.2 to comply with order dated 12.11.2024.

2. The petitioner got his car, make Swift VDI, bearing Registration No.PB-11-CC-2690, insured from respondent No.2-insurance company. His car was having a valid insurance policy bearing No.98000031180307182884 for the period from 28.10.2018 to 27.10.2019. His car was stolen on 01.12.2018 from the parking of Taj Resort, Sunam. An FIR No.226 dated 01.12.2018 under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 was registered at Police Station City, Sunam. Police filed report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. The surveyor was appointed by insurance company. Inaction on the part of insurance company compelled him to file an application under Section 22C of Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987

before Permanent Lok Adalat, Patiala (for short 'PLA'). PLA while allowing the application vide order dated 12.11.2024 directed insurance company to pay him ₹4,98,955/- along with interest @ 9% per annum. Insurance company asked him to submit relevant documents within 48 days from the date of order of PLA. He filed the same but to no avail. He filed execution petition before PLA and same was dismissed vide order dated 14.08.2025. PLA while dismissing execution application has observed that decree holder/petitioner has failed to comply with conditions of award. He did not get Registration Certificate of the vehicle cancelled whereas vehicle has been insured by Magma HDI General Insurance Company Ltd. for the period from 04.01.2024 to 03.01.2025 in the name of Sukhdev Singh.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would get his Registration Certificate cancelled. He may be granted liberty to approach PLA after getting Registration Certificate cancelled.

4. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to get his Registration Certificate cancelled and thereafter, approach Permanent Lok Adalat which would consider his request in accordance with law.
