1. Learned State counsel refers to paras 2 and 3 of the reply filed by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dharamkot, District Moga, dated 08.02.2026, which read thus:-

“2. That brief facts of the case are that, on the basis of application dated 07.11.2025 (Annexure P-1), moved by the petitioner, the enquiry was conducted by Superintendent of Police (H), Moga and during enquiry it is found that case bearing FIR No.26 dated 05.10.2023 under Section 7 of PC Act Police Station Vigilance Bureau Ferozepur was got registered by petitioner Sukhwinder Singh against respondent No.4 Inspector Gurwinder Singh, who was posted as SHO, Police Station Dharamkot at that time. After conclusion of trial respondent No.4 was acquitted by the Ld. Trial Court from the charges



framed against him, vide judgment dated 20.12.2024. Against said judgment, petitioner had filed an appeal before this Hon'ble Court. During enquiry, it is also found that on 14.10.2025 as per directions of state Government, search operation was conducted by the police in village Noorpur Hakima, to control this intoxicants. During said search operation police party headed by ASI Gurbhinder Singh visited the house of the petitioner, as cases under NDPS Act stand registered against the son of the petitioner namely Karanjit Singh. At that time one male person was found present there and when ASI Gurbhinder Singh enquired about his name, then said person refused to do so. Due to which ASI Gurbhinder Singh taekn out said person into the street, where inhabitants of village namely Balwinder Singh, Sukhwinder Singh and Rana Singh found present there and they informed the name of said person to ASI Gurbhinder Singh as Charanjit Singh son of Sukhwinder Singh. On this said Charanjit Singh was sent back to his house by the police party. During enquiry all the allegations levelled by the petitioner that his son was illegally apprehended by the police on 14.10.2025 were found to be false. However, it is also found that on 16.04.2025 another son of petitioner namely Karanjit Singh was apprehended red handed by the police and in this regard case bearing FIR No.81 dated 16.04.2025 under Section 22 NDPS Act Police Station Dharamkot was registered against him. During enquiry it is also submitted here that on the basis of application moved by wife of petitioner, the investigation of said case was conducted by the then DSP. Dharamkot and during investigation said case was found to be genuine and application moved by wife of petitioner was filed. During enquiry, the CDR of mobile phones of police employees mentioned by the petitioner was also obtained and it is found that said employees



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have not visited village Noorpur Hakima on 13.10.2025, as alleged by the petitioner. During enquiry all the allegations levelled by the petitioner in his application were found to be false and said application of petitioner has been filed.

3. That it is also submitted here that there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of petitioner and his family members, as alleged by the petitioner. However, petitioner has filed the instant petition only with malafide intention to create defence in favour of his son Karanjit Singh, who indulged in sale of intoxicants. So, petitioner has no cause of action to invoke extra ordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court.”

2. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.

3. Disposed of.
