Main case:

The instant petition has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No. 171 dated 18.09.2025 for offence(s) under Sections 318(4), 61 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at Police Station DLF Phase-II, Gurugram.

2. Reply/status report filed by way of affidavit dated 13.03.2026 on behalf of respondent-State is already available on file and the same is taken on record. Registry is directed to do the needful.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 28.11.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required for investigation of the case.

4. Learned State counsel on instruction from Sub-Inspector Raj Kumar, corroborates the said averment and submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.
