Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for setting aside the order dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Collector, Rupnagar; order dated 24.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Commissioner, Rupnagar Division, Rupnagar and order dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab.

2. A perusal of the order sheets would reveal that the matter has been adjourned repeatedly at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner and on the last date of hearing i.e., 18.03.2026, the following order was passed by this Court:-
