H.S. GREWAL, J (Oral):

The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of Complaint No. COMA/87/2020 tilted '*Satnam Singh V. Harbans Singh and others*' under Section 3 of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 447 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur, as well as the summoning order dated 14.08.2023 along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 29.11.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR is outcome of an unfortunate accident. It is submitted that the dispute between the parties has now been resolved and with the intervention of the respectables of the Society, the matter has indeed been compromised. He has referred to the compromise, in this regard and prays for quashing of the aforesaid FIR.



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3. This Court vide order dated 29.01.2026 had, directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

4. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur and got their statements recorded. A copy of report dated 17.03.2026 has been submitted to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

5. Learned counsel for the respondent has not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

7. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

8. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and Complaint No. COMA/87/2020 tilted '*Satnam Singh V. Harbans Singh and others*' under Section 3 of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 447 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur, as well as the summoning order dated 14.08.2023 along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners are



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hereby quashed subject to deposit of Rs.10,000/- towards costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Dispensary Welfare Fund (A/c No.45115269583).

9. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
