SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 16.03.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-28298-2013, whereby petitioners were held entitled to all consequential benefits owing to them on having earned acquittal, along with 6% interest from the date of their accrual till the date of actual realization.
