3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal has submitted copy of report dated 12.05.2026 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily



and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 128 dated 13.02.2025 under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act registered at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise, subject to payment of Rs. 20,000/- as costs to be deposited in the Punjab and Haryana High Court Dispensary Welfare Fund, A/c No. 45115269583, State Bank of India, High Court Branch, Chandigarh.
