1.                The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to release its balance payment.

2.                Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that a sum of Rs.4,51,360/- is outstanding against respondent on account of supply of surgical material.

3.                Learned State counsel submits that petitioner has not submitted requisite documents which is vigorously opposed by counsel for the petitioner.

4.                To resolve the issue, the respondent is hereby directed to point out, within 10 days from today, documents which are required to process petitioner's bills. The respondent shall release payment within six weeks from the date of submission of requisite documents.
