JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to consider his complaints dated 10.02.2021 and 12.04.2022 against officers of Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran (for short 'HSVP').

2. The petitioner claims that respondent-HSVP in gross violation of its instructions has increased amount of many contracts beyond 25%



limit. The petitioner is a public-spirited person and he has approached authorities by way of complaints dated 10.02.2021 and 12.04.2022, however, authorities have not paid any heed.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that competent authority would examine petitioner's complaints and proceed in accordance with law if any substance is found.

4. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the respondent, the petition stands disposed of. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on merits.
