1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to conduct inquiry on complaint dated 27.08.2022 pending before respondent No.3 since 2022. He is further seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to constitute a new Special Investigating Team to conduct inquiry in the aforementioned complaint.

2. On 24.12.2025, this Court passed the following order:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that a complaint was moved by petitioner, which is pending since 2023 as is evident from Annexure P-7. He has made a reference to various orders passed in the inquiry being conducted on the complaint as well as inter-department communications.

Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the official respondents.



On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Vashisth, DAG, Haryana, has put in appearance on their behalf and requests for deferment to get instructions.

List on 10.02.2026.

State counsel shall get specific instructions regarding the time frame within which the inquiry in the complaint shall be concluded.”

3. Learned State counsel submits that inquiry would be concluded within six weeks from today.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to aforesaid statement.
5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
