JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 18.03.2026, the following order was passed:-

“The learned Senior counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner sought the concession of anticipatory bail which was dismissed upto this Court. However, later, the petitioner was declared innocent. She was summoned under Section 190 Cr.P.C. necessitating the filing of the present petition. He states that cross-version has been found to be false as there are photographs of Gurmit Singh, the complainant and injured in the cross-case raising lalkaras immediately after the occurrence which could not have been possible had he received gunshot injuries.

Adjourned to 11.05.2026.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender/appear before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of one



week from today. On her doing so, learned trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

In compliance of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail.

The learned counsel for the complainant contends that the petitioner has not disclosed the factum of the first bail application being dismissed. He further contends that the petitioner is the main accused.

Heard.

The aforementioned order records that the prior bail application of the petitioner stands dismissed but later she was declared innocent.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has since surrendered and has been released on interim bail, the order dated 18.03.2026 is made absolute.
